School Capacity and Class Size

Admissions will be granted according to class size limits that ensure that standards of excellence will be maintained.

Academic and Age Policy

Students may be admitted only after receipt of previous school records. Class will be determined after transcript/report card evaluation.

A child must be:

- Four (4) years old by December 1st of the year entering Pre-kindergarten
- Five (5) years old by December 1st of the year entering Kindergarten
- Or six (6) years old by December 1st of the year entering Grade 1.

English Fluency:

Students applying to AISC who have little or no English speaking skills will complete an onsite Language Proficiency Test. At this time, students with little no English will only be admitted up to Grade 3.

Students applying to grades 9-12 are required to meet the grade level English Language requirements

Special Needs

It is the responsibility of the parents of students with special needs to disclose all documentation fully prior to an offer of admission being made so that the school administration can determine if the child's needs can be met at AISC. Failure of any applicant to disclose fully in any instance may result in the offer of acceptance being rescinded. AISC reserves the right to deny admission to students whose special needs cannot be serviced by the school.

Immunization Records

Proof of the following immunizations up-to-date based on student age are as follows:

- MMR: Measles, Mumps, and Rubella vaccines combined
- TB: Tuberculosis vaccine
- HepA: Hepatitis A vaccine
- HepB: Hepatitis B vaccine
